Checking of result:

Checking of result for this term should be as from 24th December, 2024.

To check your child's term results via our website, follow these steps as contained at the back of your scratch card. After checking the result, print and submit a copy of the print out to the form teacher on the resumption.

Termly submission: SS3 are to submit 2packets of candle each while UB1-SS2 students are to submit 1dozen each of familiar tissues. Some parents have been complaining about its scarcity.

Such parents can monetize with the sum of 3,000 so that bursar can buy it later. It is readily available in Onitsha Relieve market.

Parent's access card: Always remember to come along with your access card anytime you come to pick your daughter /ward from school including visiting days. New parents take note.

Prospectus: On resumption, every item will be checked as usual, so endeavour to check your child's prospectus every term. It is important parents provide necessary things for their wards at the beginning of every term to avoid the unnecessary phone calls or visits.

Visiting days: new parents should remember that visiting day is 2nd Sunday of every month as from 12noon to 5pm. Any other visit should be strictly in the office within school hours.
